The 21th annual NOITS conference (<u>www.noits.org</u>) will be held in Reykjavik, 14-15 May 2020. The conference will be hosted by the University of Akureyri in co-operation with the University of Reykjavík.

The keynote speakers are Amit Khandelwal (Columbia GSB), Woan Foong Wong (University of Oregon) and Isabel Vansteenkiste (European Central Bank).

The local organizers will pay for accommodation. Some funding for those unable to cover their travel expenses is available (priority given to PhD students).

The Nordic International Trade Seminars (NOITS) was established in Stockholm, March 1998, at the network's first annual conference. NOITS aims to organize annual events with presentations by Nordic researchers and graduate students specializing in international economics. In addition a few non-Nordic researchers with a considerable international reputation will be invited. The network serves several purposes. First, it facilitates collaborative research and scientific contacts among Nordic researchers. Second, it offers graduate students and junior researchers an opportunity to present their work, and thereby get valuable feedback, as well as to prepare for international workshops and conferences. Third, it is hoped to strengthen the ties between the Nordic academic institutions.
