

Call for Papers

NOITS Annual Workshop 2009

Copenhagen, May 15-16, 2009

The twelfth annual NOITS workshop will be held in Copenhagen, 15-16 May 2009. The workshop will be hosted by Copenhagen Business School and organized by the NOITS organising committee (see <http://www.noits.org/>).

The non-Nordic speakers for the 2009 workshop will be *David Hummels*, Purdue University, and *Esteban Rossi-Hansberg*, Princeton University.

The number of participants will be restricted to approximately 30. Accommodation expenses will be paid for by the local organisers. Doctoral students submitting papers are encouraged to seek travel grants from the Nordic Network in Economics (see their homepage at www.hecer.fi/NNE/). The Nordic International Trade Seminars (NOITS) was established in Stockholm, March 1998, at the network's first annual workshop. NOITS aims to organise annual workshops with presentations by Nordic researchers and graduate students specialising in international economics. In addition a few non-Nordic researchers with a considerable international reputation will be invited. The network serves several purposes. First, it facilitates collaborative research and scientific contacts among Nordic researchers. Second, it offers graduate students and junior researchers an opportunity to present their work, and thereby get valuable feedback, as well as to prepare for international workshops and conferences. Third, it is hoped to strengthen the ties between the Nordic academic institutions.
