<u>Getting from Arlanda airport to ProfilHotels | Riddargatan:</u>

<u>Option 1:</u> Take the Arlanda Express train from Arlanda airport to T-Centralen, which is the only stop. From T-Centralen metro station, take the red line, number 14 towards *Mörby Centrum* and get off at **Östermalmstorg**. Walk to the hotel following the map above.


- Arlanda Express one-way tickets cost 320 SEK, and round-trip tickets cost 600 SEK.
- Buy tickets <u>here</u> or at ticket machines the airport.

<u>Option 2:</u> Airport coaches (Flygbussarna) from Arlanda airport to Stockholm Central Station (a.k.a. T-Centralen). From T-Centralen metro station, take the red line, number 14 towards *Mörby Centrum* and get off at **Östermalmstorg**. Walk to the hotel following the map above.

- One-way tickets cost around 130 SEK, and round-trip tickets cost 210 SEK.
- Buy tickets <u>here</u> or at the airport.

<u>Option 3:</u> Cab directly to the hotel. Plenty of cabs readily available upon arrival. However, this option is quite expensive – around 674 SEK from the airport to the city center.

<u>Getting to the conference venue:</u>



- Metro from the city center: red line, number 14 towards *Mörby Centrum*.
- Metro stop: Universitetet
- Follow the arrow to Aula Magna
- The conference takes place in room **Bergsmannen** on the 7th floor

- From the City Center: Take the metro from **Östermalmstorg** towards *T*-*Centralen/Fruangen/Liljeholmen*, red line.
- Get off at **Gamla Stan** stop.
